

Artistry Magic!

A pianist with **artistry** can change from loud to soft quickly.
 This musical pattern changes from *f* to *p* as it moves up the keyboard.

1. First, play only *p* as you practice the “hop” to each new pattern.
2. Now play and change from *f* to *p* for each pattern.



Finger Hops (for R.H. alone)

Hint: Play close to the keys with firm fingertips.
